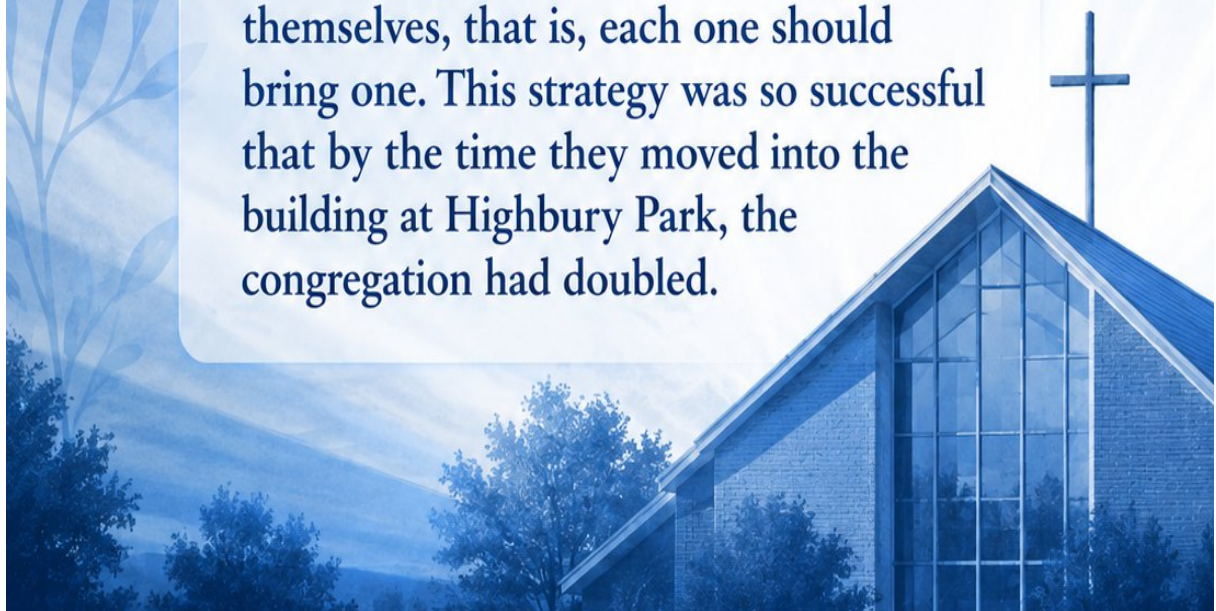

This strategy was so successful that by the time they moved into the building at Highbury Park, the congregation had doubled.
