THE HISTORY OF THE Highbury Park Church of Christ

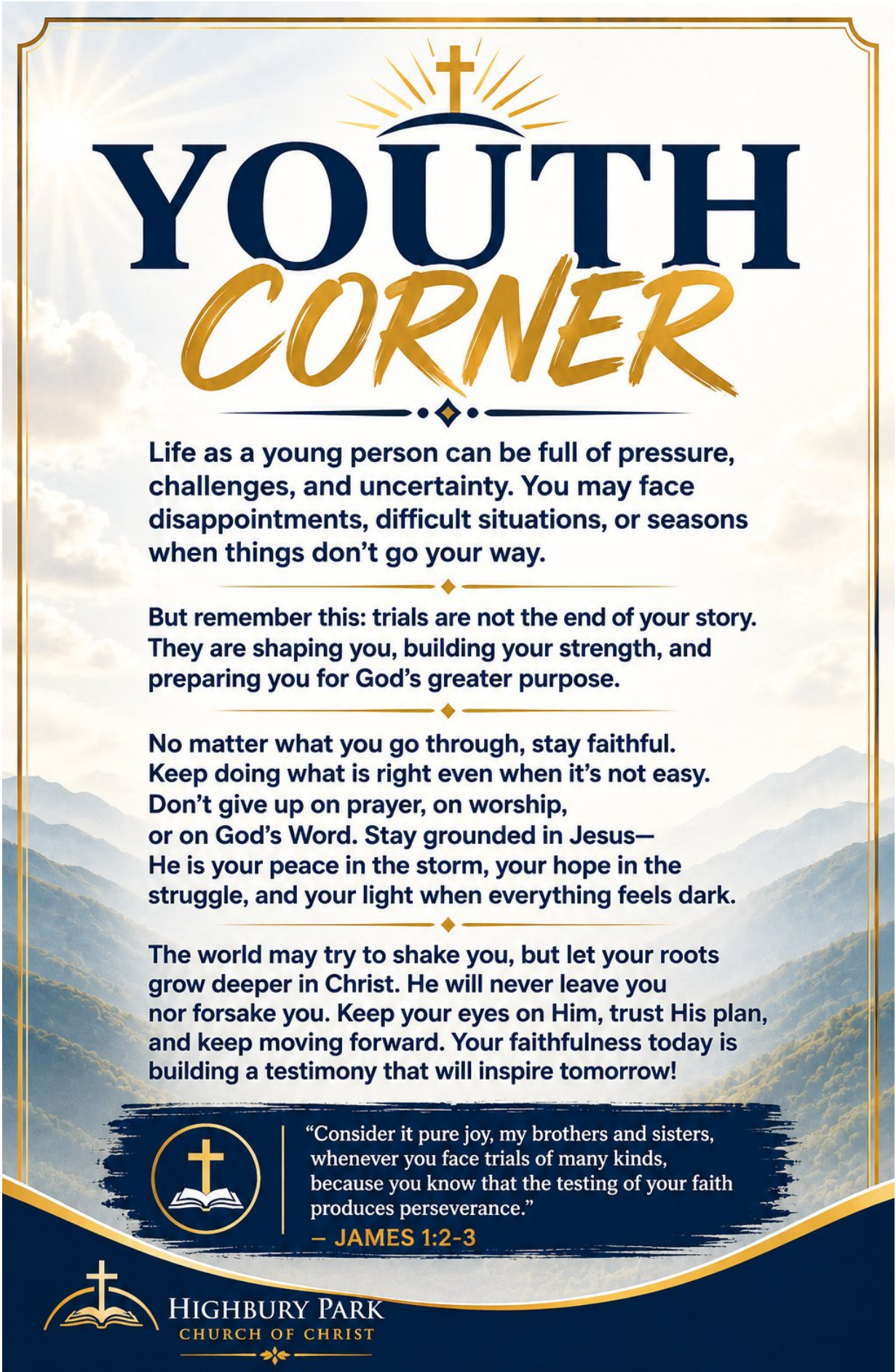


The history of the Highbury Park Church of Christ dates to the early 1950s when the first congregation in The Bahamas was established under the leadership of William Miller, Carl Strachan, Irvin Forbes and Jesse Dean. The congregation initially met at Lily of the Valley Street off East Street but relocated around 1958 to the St. James Road area. By April 1966 the church had relocated to its current location at Highbury Park.

Several outreach programmes fostered a close-knit family environment that cemented the foundation for the church for decades to come. Two singing groups emerged: the Spiritual Roots and the Ladies Chorale. Later, a youth group was formed called the Challengers and Conquerors Christian Club (or 4C's).

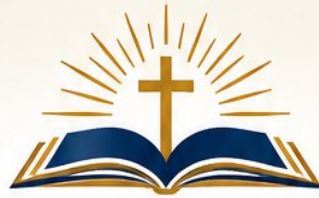
